

SUMP - Stewardship: Commitment of TIME, TALENT, OR TREASURE

TIME AND TALENT NEEDS:

➤ **Catechist** - Group Leaders needed to implement daily 8 AM to 1 PM Lesson plans for a group of a dozen children. All volunteers are subject to a Background Screening (CORI) and Protecting God’s Children Training (2 hour long safe environment program before start of program). All volunteers should be kid friendly and have a knowledge and active practice of their Catholic Faith.

➤ **Coordinators - We have 4 identified areas , each area requiring a Coordinator:**
The Coordinator arranges a team of volunteers. Helpful skills for the Coordinator are: the ability to network with other families participating in the program to illicit help; organization skills for scheduling calendar with volunteers, coordinating donations.
Coordinators have a broad range of autonomy within their Service area.

- 1) Witness Talk Coordinator** - Recruits Daily Witness Talks from individuals involved in Ministries in Saint Agnes or from the local Community
- 2) Lunch Coordinator** - Recruits Lunch Monitors for Their Grade Level week, Manages Food Donations for Daily Snacks, Clean Up and Set Up for Snack & Lunch Time
- 3) Social Justice Coordinator** - Reaches out to Saint Agnes Ministries and local Community Non- profit organizations to develop and implement daily social justice projects.
- 4) Classroom Coordinator** - Ensures that all classes are in appropriate condition following each day’s session; supplies needed for upcoming sessions are available

Coordinators’ Meeting with Director of Faith Formation: March 29, 6:30 PM to 7:30 PM
Agenda: establish plan of action and implementation for their service area. Discussion regarding SUMP fee reductions for those who volunteer as a Coordinator is being considered.

TIME NEEDS:

➤ **Facilities Clean Up -**
Daily (Monday through Friday) - Empty Trash at end of every day.
End of Week (Friday) - Sweep classrooms, clean tables and dry erase boards.

TREASURE NEEDS:
